



Call for New Members of the International Committee of ICEEP

The International Committee of ICEEP is adding 3-4 new members, to replace retiring board members, and is calling for nominations from individuals interested in serving on the International Committee of ICEEP. The mission of ICEEP is to advance the understanding of the physiology, function and health of athletic horses through promotion of scientific research.

International committee members typically serve terms of 12 years. They are involved in the planning and execution of three ICEEP quadrennial conferences, and any mid-term meetings held between quadrennial meetings.
